PROSPECTUS

1. GENERALINFORMATION

Aninha Educational Institute, newly Higher Secondary School is a coeducational Institution under the Aninha Educational Trust, Sao Jose De Areal, Nessai. The School is recognized by Goa Board of Higher Secondary Education, Alto Betim and by the Department of Education, Porvorim.

2. DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION.

Candidates seeking admission to Std XI for Arts and Science streams are required to produce Original and photo-copied certified copies of the following documents along with their applications. Applications may be obtained from the school office upon payment.

- 1. Statement of marks S.S.C. or equivalent Examination (2 copies)
- 2. Original School Leaving Certificate from the last School attended which however shall not be returned.
- 3. Provisional Eligibility Certificate from the Goa Board of Secondary, Alto Betim, Goa, in case of those students who have passed their S.S.C. Examination from Boards other than the Goa Board of Secondary Education.
- 4. Character Certificate from the last School attended.
- 5. Original Birth Certificate.
- 6. Caste Certificate.
- 7. Copy of Student's Adhar Card

3. VALIDITY OF ADMISSION

- 1. Admissions once made are valid for ONE YEAR ONLY and such have to be renewed for the subsequent year of study.
- 2. The admissions of students above the age of 18 years is at the discretion of the Principal.
- 3. The Principal reserves the right to refuse admission to a student whose past academic record and conduct is considered as unsatisfactory.

4. Once admission is confirmed, the leaving certificate will not be returned. You will have to take leaving certificate of our school after 15 days from the date of admission.

4. RULES AND REGULATIONS

The school attaches great significance and importance to moral & spiritual formation, discipline and character building; hence every student of this Institution shall comply with the following rules of conduct.

- 1. Students are expected to take proper care of the school property and assist in keeping the premises neat and tidy.
- 2. Students must compulsorily attend all classes regularly and under no circumstances, leave the classrooms without prior sanction of the teachers and the school premises without the permission of the Principal.
- 3. Students must give due respect to the teachers and other members of the staff.
- 4. Students should produce a note of absence in support of their absence, failing which they may not be permitted to attend the following days' classes. They shall also bring their parents/guardian when asked to do so by the Principal.
- 5. The School uniform is compulsory for all the students. To ensure uniformity in color and the pattern of the uniform, it will be stitched by a tailor hired by the institution. **No alteration in the uniform is allowed.**
- 6. The students are duty bound to refer to the Notice Board everyday as all important matters shall be placed on the School Notice Board from time to time.
- 7. In case of failure to attend the college, **refund of the fees paid by the student will not be made.**

5. EXAMINATION:

- a) I Mid Term Examination will be held in August 2024
- b) I Term Examination will be held in October 2024
- c) II Term Examination will be held in February/March 2025

A minimum of 75% Attendance is required in order to appear for the school or public examination.

Promotion from Std XI to XII will depend on the average marks secured in each subject and will be done as per the promotion rules of the Goa Board.

6. FEESAND STRUCTURE

All fees are to be paid in cash at the time of admission. Fees include Enrolment, Pupil's Fund, Term, PTA, Examination, Laboratory Fees and Laboratory deposits, etc.

SCHOLARSHIPS

The Government gives National Scholarship, Loan Scholarships, Merit Scholarships, Schedule Caste/Schedule Tribe Scholarships, etc. Information regarding Government Scholarships will be displayed on the

Notice Board as and when received by the Institution.

7. CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

Students can participate in any of the co-curricular activities like Sports, Drama, Elocution, etc. conducted by the school.

8. FOR ATTENTION OF PARENTS AND GUARDIANS:
